
Sine Law Worksheet

$$\frac{65}{\sin 75^{\circ}} = \frac{b}{\sin 48^{\circ}}$$


$$\frac{75}{\sin 55^{\circ}} = \frac{c}{\sin 80^{\circ}}$$

$$\frac{36}{\sin B} = \frac{25}{\sin 25}$$


$$\frac{50}{\sin C} = \frac{42}{\sin 60}$$
